Tennessee Tax Freeze Jurisdictions

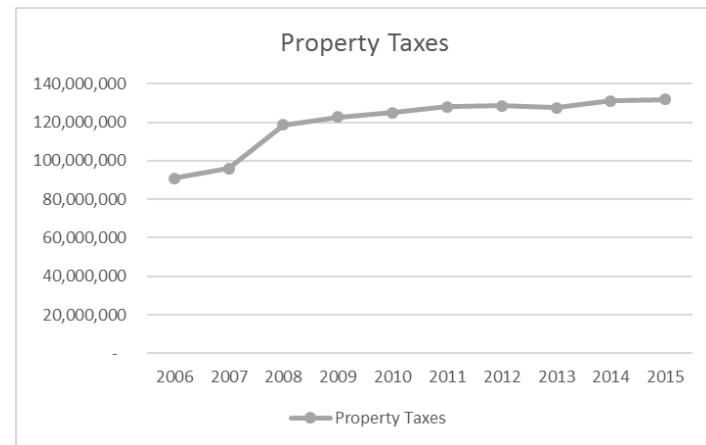


